1955-57 TBird Classes

All Cars must have either hard or convertible top installed and windows up. You may show your car with no top but will lose 3 points in judging.

Primary Class - Cars may be Original or Modified. Cars must be driven to the show. Judged with hoods and trunks closed.

Senior Class - Cars which are of show quality and have won a 1st Place Award (Gold) in a sanctioned CTCI event. These cars may not be entered in Primary Class. Judged with hoods and trunks open.

1958-05 TBird Classes

Open - Convertible tops and windows must be up, hoods & trunks closed. **Closed -** Hardtops, Sunroofs and Landaus. Windows must be up, hoods and trunks closed.

Custom TBird Classes

Open to all Thunderbirds in two classes. Cars with any combination of paint, trim, wheels, interior, drive train, suspension, body work, etc. that is arguably dissimilar from the original; must participate in this class. All other presentation rules apply. Note: Certain modifications intended to enhance safety or serviceability while preserving originality are excepted. Examples are: seat belts, disc brakes, certain engine components, air conditioning radial tires and so forth.

Display TBird Class

Open to all Thunderbirds. No judging.

Invitational Classes

Judging is based on Fit, Finish & Workmanship. Owners are encouraged to join the judging teams.

Event Control

Show management shall determine, in it's sole judgement, the final competition class of all vehicles upon entry inspection. Vehicles improperly registered will be reassigned to the appropriate class.

Show will be held RAIN or SHINE. There is no rain date. There will be no refunds of entry fees after September 7, 2025, no exceptions.

Join the fun at Southern California's longest running All Thunderbird Show. Judging is based on Fit, Finish & Workmanship. All Original, Restored or Modified Thunderbirds and Invitational Classes, with the exception of Display Class. will compete for handsome awards & trophies.
