Please know that much thought has gone into this, and our decision has not been made lightly. On so many levels, it would simply be easier to remain at Palm Springs.

However...

Since we have already gathered as a group at the Nationals in Ventura, we feel that hosting this year's Fan Belt Toss at the OC Fairgrounds offers a tremendous opportunity to promote our vehicles and our clubs to a whole new audience outside the established Corvair network. It is our hope that this new audience will not only see and appreciate the passion and enthusiasm we already share for our vehicles, but also the overall affordability and support network available as a Corvair owner.

The OC Fair Grounds offers an average attendance of 10,000 people each weekend as part of the OC Market Place. At even a 1% interest, that's 100 new people to buy your parts, buy your cars, or resurrect a Corvair from the junk yard.

It is not our intention to remove the Fan Belt Toss from Palm Springs permanently. We know we're breaking from tradition and taking a risk with this one-time change of venue, but we believe the upside potential to grow Corvair awareness and enthusiasm to a fresh, captive audience just makes good sense and is simply too good to pass up - especially this year.
